Team GB win the Women's World Trophy in 2022 for the first time ever! Rosie Rowett, Jane Daniels and Nieve Holmes all add an FIM World Championship gold medal to their collection. Rosie was selected to ride for Team GB in the Women's Trophy class for the third time, following podium results in 2019 and 2021 (third and second respectively). The Women's team were also awarded the prestigious Watling Trophy by the FIM which is given to the team for the Best Overall Performance of the event.

The Team GB Women's team were on it from the get go on Day 1, finishing second in the team category while Rosie finished 8th in class. Day 1 consisted solely of cross tests which was a great way to ease into the event while still being technical and challenging. Day 2 was the same loop as Day 1 and the enhanced knowledge of the tests meant everyone was faster. Even so, the women held onto their second place in class and Rosie finished 9th.



Days 3 and 4 were the same loop and some tougher, enduro tests were introduced, one of which took over two hours to walk! However, these tests suited British riders well and Rosie finished 8th in class and the Women's team retained second place. Day 4 was Rosie's best day personally, finishing fourth in Tests 4 and 5 and finishing 7th overall which was incredible!

On Day 4, leading USA Women's team rider Brandy Richards suffered a crash and unfortunately had to pull out, taking the team out of the runnings and promoting Team GB into first place.

Day 5 saw a new loop where Rosie finished 7th in class and the team remained in first with an 11 minute lead over second placed France. The Women's team just had to safely finish the final motocross test in order to win, which they did and the celebrations began!

It was a week of a lifetime and the team are over the moon with the Women's and Rosie's result! It takes a huge amount of physical and mental strength to ride for six days in a row, five of which involve eight hours of riding! The team are also incredibly proud of Jane Daniels for winning the Women's class overall being the fastest individual woman!
